SIZE OF POSTER

Useable size of your poster:

138 cm height x 95 cm width (A0)

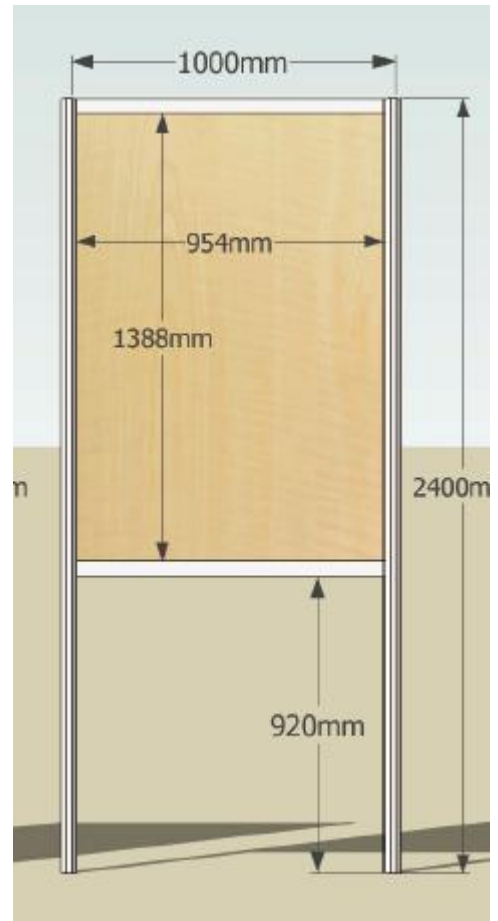
PREPARING YOUR POSTER

Text on poster

- Use a clear typeface and, if possible, a laser printer.
- The poster should be readable from a distance of 2-3 meters. This means that all lettering should be at least 8mm high.
- Please prepare a title banner which is in a bigger font than the rest of the text and graphs. The title should also contain the name(s) and affiliations(s) of the author(s).

Graphs and diagrams

- Graphs and figures should be readable from a distance of 2-3 meters.
- They should be drawn with a minimum line width of 1 mm.



AT THE SEMINAR

General Information

- A printed number identifying the place of your poster will be provided on the board.

Poster Mounting

- Posters should be mounted on **Wednesday, March 9 by 12:00 hours.**
- Posters should be mounted with tape provided by the organisation.

Poster Viewing and Presentation

- The poster area is open for poster viewing on *Wednesday, March 9, until Friday, March 11.*
- On **Thursday**, poster presenters are requested to be present at their poster in order to answer questions from delegates, between **13:15 – 13:45 hours.**

Removing your poster material

- Material should be removed between **13.30 and 15.00 hours on Friday, March 11.**
- Material that has not been taken down by the author(s) will be removed and disposed of by the Organizers.
